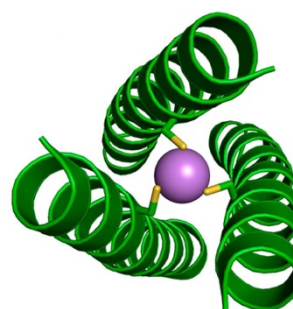

**Title:** *Metal Templated Heterotrimeric Coiled Coils: how to make them, why they are stable and what are their limitations.*

He is an expert in bioinorganic and supramolecular chemistry, having made substantive contributions to the understanding of photosynthetic water oxidation and vanadium biochemistry. He served as an Associate Editor for Inorganic Chemistry for over 20 year and is a fellow of both the ACS and AAAS.*
