Curriculum: “Scienze Chimiche” / ”Chemical Sciences”

Requisites for admission

For the admission to the Master Degree in Chemical Sciences, students are required to have knowledge in basic fields, such as chemistry, physics and mathematics.

In order to enroll in the master program, you will need:

- A bachelor (min 3 years) in Chemical Sciences of L-27 and L-21 classes as indicated in the Ministerial Decree 509/99.
- Alternatively, a minimum of 20 credits (CTU) of courses in the field of mathematical disciplines, physics and computer science, and of 30 credits (CTU) of courses in chemical disciplines, with particular, but not exclusive, reference to analytical chemistry (CHEM-01/A), physical chemistry (CHEM-02/A), inorganic chemistry (CHEM-03/A), organic chemistry (CHEM05/A) and biochemistry (BIOS-07/A).
- To possess an adequate knowledge of the English language (minimum level required is B2 for the curriculum “Chemical Sciences” and B1 for the curriculum “Scienze Chimiche”). The knowledge of the English language of level B2 should be demonstrated by showing an internationally recognized B2 level certificate or will be assessed through a placement test.

HOW TO ENROLL

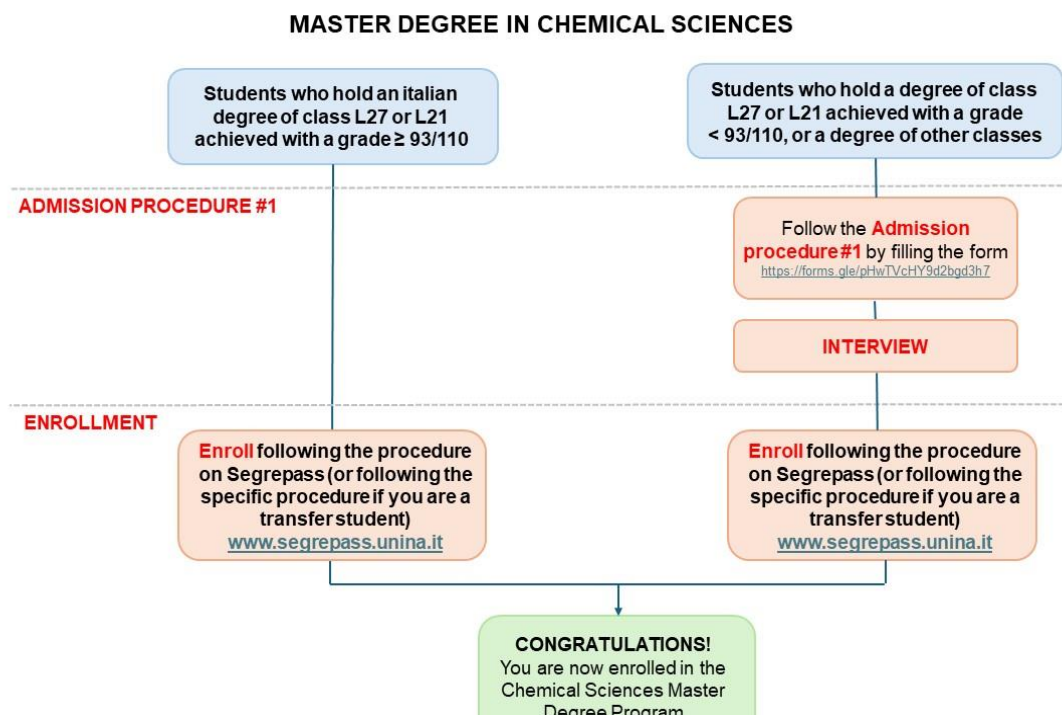
In order to become a student of the new master program you will need to be admitted to the program and then enroll. These are two different procedures that need to be done in sequence.

STUDENTS WHO HOLD AN ITALIAN BACHELOR’S DEGREE

- If you hold an **Italian bachelor’s** degree of class **L27** or L21 (see D.M. 509/99) achieved with a **grade equal or higher than 93/110**, you may **directly ENROLL** following the procedure available on Segrepass (www.segrepass.unina.it).
- If you hold an **Italian bachelor’s** degree of class **L27** or L21 (see D.M. 509/99) achieved with **a grade lower than 93/110**, or **if you possess a bachelor’s degree of other classes**, you have to apply for the admission following the **ADMISSION PROCEDURE #1** by providing a **Transcript of Records (ToR)** with a detailed description of the courses attended and the exams passed to obtain the final degree. After verification of the possession of curricular requirements, you will be contacted for an interview.

Upon positive conclusion of the evaluation procedure, you will obtain a **Pre-Acceptance Letter** from the program coordinator to be used for the **ENROLLMENT** procedure available on Segrepass (www.segrepass.unina.it).



STUDENTS WHO HOLD A FOREIGN BACHELOR'S DEGREE

Students who hold a **foreign bachelor's degree** have to apply to the **ADMISSION procedure #2** that is common to all the students of any nationality, and it is mandatory in order to verify the requirements and to confirm your knowledge of English. The **ENROLLMENT** procedure is different depending on if you are an Italian, EU or Extra-EU prospective student.

ADMISSION procedure #2 (common to ALL the students - Italian, EU and Extra-EU)

In order to apply to the **ADMISSION procedure #2**, you will need the following documents:

- Bachelor Diploma
- Transcript of Records (ToR) with a detailed description of the courses attended and the exams passed to obtain the final degree.
- Copy of your passport (only for foreign students)
- Updated CV
- Certificate of English language (when available/necessary)
- Other relevant documents

Once you have gathered all the documents, fill in the online form available at:

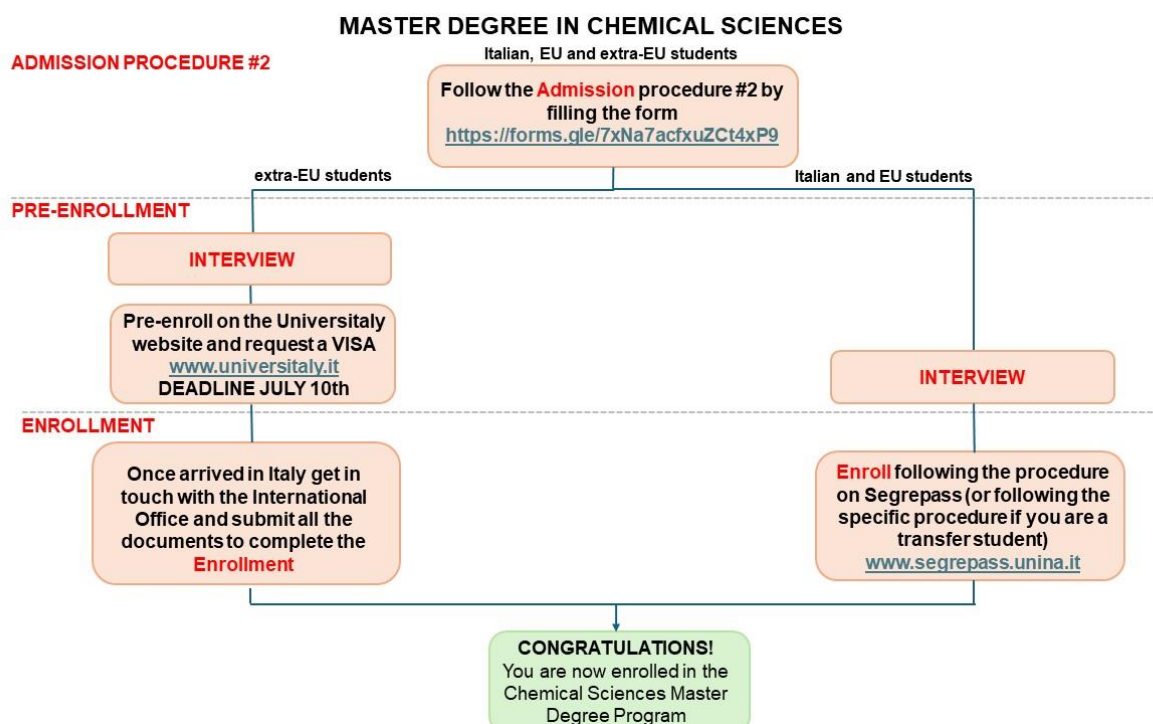

Download, fill in, sign and upload again the [FORM1 Recognition of Foreign University Title](#) and upload all the documents as a **SINGLE PDF** file in the admission form.

After verification of the possession of curricular requirements, you will be contacted for an interview.

Upon positive conclusion of the evaluation procedure, you will obtain a **Pre-Acceptance Letter** from the program coordinator to be used for the **ENROLLMENT** procedure and to request the VISA (when necessary).

Following the **ADMISSION**, Italian Students and Foreign Students will have to follow different enrollment procedures. Briefly, Italian and EU Students will need to enroll using [SegrePass](#) while Extra-EU Students will need to enroll through <https://www.university.it/>.
